

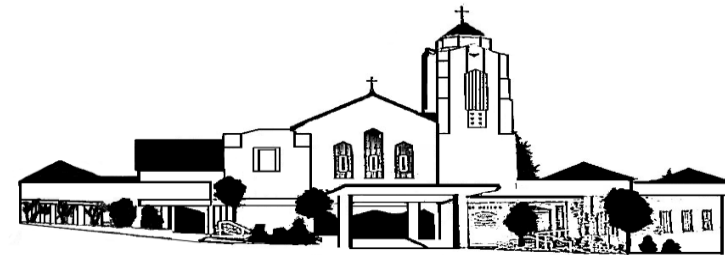

The CWL is a national organization rooted in gospel values calling its members to holiness through service to the people of God. Along with growing in our own faith life, our members have been very active in supporting our parish and other organizations. Last year we gave \$14,000 to St. Peter's Building Fund and \$4,050 to various charities and religious affiliations. Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

Once again, in the penitential season of Lent, I am appealing to you to participate in this year's Share Lent Campaign, led by the Canadian Catholic Organization for Development and Peace.

As the Canadian member of Caritas Internationalis, Development and Peace works with frontline partners in Asia, Africa, Latin America and the Middle East. With a preferential option for the poor, D&P delivers emergency relief to those suffering severe hardships arising from natural disasters and war. It is also active in fostering ongoing reconstruction and supporting human rights.

This year's Share Lent theme is "Create a Climate of Change." It derives from Pope Francis's two interconnected pleas to the whole human family.
