**A Note for Ministers of Holy Communion.**

Unfortunately it may happen that someone spills some of the consecrated wine/precious blood in the process of receiving communion. The minister should then move to another place so that people do not step on the spot where the consecrated wine was spilled. After having distributed the cup for communion the minister should place a towel or cloth over the place where the consecrated wine was spilled, so that it can be cleaned carefully and properly after Mass.
