BC residents who go to Church are qualified for public flu vaccination.** Please pick up an influenza Immunization Record/Consent Form from the back of the church. Please bring the filled out form along with your care card on the day you are going to receive the flu shot. This year, National Advisory Committee on Immunization has recommended health professionals to offer high dose vaccine (Fluzone HD) to people 65 years and older. **The cost is approximately \$ 75. If you would like to receive this high dose, please sign up on the sheet provided at the back of the church.**
