**Celebration of the Anointing of the sick.** We will celebrate the sacrament of the sick at all weekend Masses.

Here are some guidelines to receive the anointing of the sick.

All whose health is seriously impaired by sickness or old age may receive this sacrament.

The sacrament may be repeated if the sick person recovers after being anointed and then falls ill or if during the same illness the person's condition becomes more serious.

A sick person may be anointed before surgery.

Elderly people may be anointed if they become weakened even though there is no serious illness.

All children who have made their first communion may be anointed.

The celebration of the sacrament consists of laying on of hands and anointing on the forehead and hands along with the prayer, "through this holy anointing may the Lord in his love and mercy help you with the grace of the Holy Spirit. May the Lord who frees you from sin save you and raise you up".
