A Note to Ministers of Communion. There is a eucharistic minister's schedule on the board at the entrance of the church. It contains the names of the eucharistic ministers for every Mass. These are the eucharistic ministers that come to the altar first at the time for communion. If a eucharistic minister is absent, another eucharistic minister in the assembly comes to the altar to replace the absent minister.
