Please note:

1. Lent ends on Holy Thursday afternoon. The Mass on Thursday evening is the beginning of the "Easter Triduum", the "Three Great Days" of Easter which continue until Easter Sunday evening. The high point of the feast of Easter is the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday night.
2. Good Friday is a day of fast and abstinence. It is also recommended on Holy Saturday.
3. There are opportunities for the sacrament of reconciliation on Good Friday morning from 9:30 - 11:30 am and Holy Saturday afternoon from 4:00 - 6:00 pm.

Feast of the Divine Mercy - April 28: Everyone is welcome to celebrate with us. The Legion of Mary will lead a nine-day prayer to start on Good Friday. The first three days are to be done privately and the rest after Daily Mass. On the Feast Day it will be at 1:30 pm with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and exactly at 3 pm, we shall pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy followed by fellowship.
