PROJECT ADVANCE 2020 - Our Catholic Response to the Crisis:

Project Advance has some key changes this year. Archdiocesan funding priorities from this year's Appeal will be directed to a newly established Crisis Response Fund, to help vulnerable individuals and families during this time of pandemic, alongside other ministries of evangelization and outreach. The Archdiocesan goal has been reduced to \$1.625 million and St. Peter's target has been reduced from **\$36,500 to \$18,250**.

The Appeal will officially launch during the week of June 8th when past supporters of Project Advance can expect to receive a letter from Archbishop Miller. More details of the Appeal will be published in the BC Catholic and will be available at www.projectadvance.ca. With your support during this very unusual time, Project Advance will again meet the needs of both our parish community and the Archdiocese.
