**Church Reopening:**

This week, Dr. Bonnie Henry announced that indoor worship services with up to 50 people will be allowed to resume. With that in mind and in discussion with leaders in our Parish community as well as giving some time to organize the resumption of liturgies, we propose to **begin the weekend of June 5-6 with a Mass at 5 PM Saturday (also live streamed) and Sunday at 11 AM. Weekday Masses will resume the following week, with two services, Tuesday and Thursday at Noon.** We are starting slow to facilitate the logistics of reopening and if subsequent interest and volunteers increase, we can increase the number of Masses as well. Livestreaming will continue for the time being, possibly until full reopening. Masks are mandatory for all who attend with the exception of the presider, lector or soloist. **You will be required to pre-register for the Weekend services on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, 9 am to 2 pm at 604-522-4611x3.** Essentially, it will be the same as it was when we were briefly open the past Summer and Fall.
