Development & Peace/Caritas Canada: Fall Action Campaign - People & Planet First

While global leaders were meeting in the COP26 talks about how to tackle climate change, more & more activists are being threatened and killed for protecting the forests, waters & biodiversity that our people and planet are most in need of. The most vulnerable members of our human family are bearing the largest burden, dealing with the worst impacts of climate change and facing negative effects of ill-planned, top-down climate "solutions". For over a decade, Canadian companies have been expected to care for the environment and respect human rights. And yet, the lived experiences of Development & Peace partner organizations demonstrate that existing measures are not effective in preventing human and environmental abuses around the world. **We want the obligation to prevent human rights violations to be legally binding.** Canadian companies will have to develop & implement human rights & environmental rights due diligence procedures for their entire supply & value chains and report on it. With due diligence legislation, if a company fails to undertake reasonable steps the victims of any harm will have access to remedy and meaningful consequences through Canadian courts. A petition is available on-line at devp.org/eng/campaign/people-planet-first/take-action or at the back of the church to hold Canadian companies working overseas accountable. As Pope Francis has said People and Planet first means "a different kind of economy: one that brings life not death: one that is inclusive and not exclusive, humane and not dehumanizing, one that cares for the environment and does not despoil it".
