

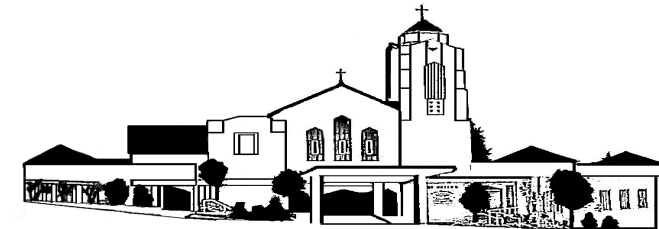

WELCOME TO ST. PETER'S!

Synod 2021-2024: In April we completed the parish phase of the Synod process. Many shared their perspectives on a number of questions. Below is the final section of our parish synthesis that was submitted to the Archdiocese. Let us discern together how the Holy Spirit is calling us to grow.

From this time of listening, could you sum up in one or two sentences how the Spirit is calling us to grow in "journeying together"?

We need to unite together in **love** as brothers and sisters in the Body of Christ, and **listen** to one another in a spirit of openness, understanding, compassion, empathy, patience, respect, inclusiveness, forgiveness and reconciliation as we adapt to our changing times and journey together for a better society. By letting the Holy Spirit fill our hearts and fill our Church, He will guide and help us so that we can be open to the changes needed and work and move forward together on issues of justice and equality for all.

After having received reports from 65 parishes, the Archdiocese of Vancouver created a synthesis Report. As Archbishop Miller wrote, "this Report testifies to the benefits of prayerfully listening and sharing one's heartfelt concerns about how the Church is living its mission. I am very grateful to all who gave their time and provided their input into this synodal process that is now unfolding in the life of the Church. If it is successful, it will help the People of God to discern prayerfully the signs of the times in the light of our faith so that we can grow in our personal relationship to Jesus Christ and fruitfully serve the mission he has entrusted to us." Finally, after the Reports from the Bishops' Conferences around the world were sent to the Vatican, a synthesis Report was written by an international group of bishops, priests, consecrated men and women, and lay men and women.
