

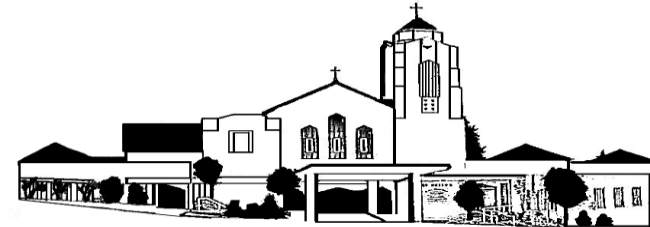

On this, the 2nd Sunday of Easter, we continue our celebration of the Resurrection of Jesus. The celebration of the Easter Season continues for fifty days. During this time we reflect on how our sharing in the Resurrection of Jesus impacts our life as baptized followers of Christ. During this time, we look forward together to the great celebration of Pentecost, when we receive the gift of the Holy Spirit to continue Christ's mission in the world. This Sunday is also known as Divine Mercy Sunday. This celebration points us to the merciful love of God that lies behind the whole Paschal Mystery. This message was highlighted in a series of revelations to St. Maria Faustina Kowalska in the 1930s. Our confidence in the mercy of God is expressed beautifully in the prayer connected with Divine Mercy devotions: "Jesus, I trust in you".
