Stewardship Reflection - Jan. 28 - 4th Sunday in Ordinary Time

In today's Gospel St. Mark mentions twice that Jesus taught with "authority." This authority did not come because of Jesus' position or title. Jesus' authority came from God. As stewards of our common vocation – discipleship – we too have access to authority from God through the Holy Spirit. All the baptized have access to a charismatic authority. When we humbly place ourselves under the authority of the Holy Spirit, then and only then are we given any authority and the charisma and wisdom to lead others to Christ. This is stewardship of the Good News.
